Requirements

General requirements:

- Be an active CMF surgeon with a global reputation
- Possess broad knowledge and experience regarding issues within the AO Foundation and AOCMF by way of being a present or past member of an International Board, Regional Board, International Commission, or AOCMF Trustee
- Have a positive international reputation and strong personal relationships
- Be able and willing to work in an ecumenical, constructive and inclusive way with surgeons of different surgical backgrounds, including but not limited to Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons, Plastic Surgeons, Otolaryngologists, Head & Neck Surgeons, Ophthalmology and Oculoplastic Surgeons, and Neurosurgeons
- Have international experience by way of fellowship, faculty, or research travel
- Be a current or past member or officer on key national, regional, or international CMF associations
- Be a clear and effective communicator and a good listener with an excellent command of the English language
- Possess the ability to work in a multicultural environment
- Be prepared to spend an average of six days per month on AOCMF/AO Foundation matters
- Have good project management skills (including the ability to effectively delegate authority), as well as strong diplomatic skills

- Be a selfless team builder who can set direction and motivate a team to work together to achieve goals
- Be willing and able to travel globally (with no exclusions) to represent interests of all members of the AO Foundation (> 10 trips annually)

Education-related requirements:

- Must be an active AOCMF faculty, preferred holding a position at a university or at an academic institution
- Should be recognized as an outstanding educator
- Have high motivation to build, manage and maintain educational programs
- Must be a current or past AOCMF faculty member or chair of at least eight courses

R&D-related requirements:

- Significant research experience is a must
- Strong global scientific reputation, supported by high quality academic publications, books, etc, is preferred

Responsibilities

- Be accountable to the AOCMF International Board
- Ensure that the objectives of the AOCMF Middle East and Northern Africa Board are achieved by fulfilling the duties of the board
- Coordinate all functions, budgets, and activities of AOCMF Middle East and Northern Africa
- Present and represent the interests of AOCMF Middle East and Northern Africa on the AOCMF International Board and of AOCMF in general vis-à-vis third parties and the public
- Ensure the compliance of the AOCMF Middle East and Northern Africa Board with the bylaws and regulations of the AO Foundation
- Comply to the AO Foundation Code of Ethics and Shared Values
- Closely collaborate with the AOCMF management staff for the fulfillment of these tasks
- Create, assign, and review board members' tasks
- Assemble and conduct efficient and effective AOCMF Middle East and Northern Africa Board meetings
- Include all necessary agenda and documentation connected therewith
- Sign and issue the minutes of the AOCMF Middle East and Northern Africa Board
- Ensure timely, fair, and transparent succession planning within AOCMF Middle East and Northern Africa
- Supervise the implementation of AOCMF Middle East and Northern Africa Board resolutions, actions, and budget expenditures
- Ensure collaboration and cooperation with other AO bodies and approved industrial partners
- Oversee the content of all educational programs within AOCMF Middle East and Northern Africa
- Ensure the avoidance of bias in faculty selection and rotation
- Ensure and support the AOCMF management in the efficient and effective course planning process (including mid-term planning)
- Ensure compliance of AOCMF educational activities in Middle East and Northern Africa with the binding AO Foundation rules, regulations, and contractual obligations
