Requirements

General

- Must – a CMF surgeon in active practice
- Must – Regional reputation and strong personal relationships / recognition regionally
- Desired - International experience e.g.; fellowship, faculty or research travel
- Desired - Is or has been a recognized member or officer on key national, regional, or Intl CMF associations
- Must - Good / clear communicator, good listener with the ability to work in multi-cultural environments
- Must - Good command of English Language
- Must - Is prepared to spend the equivalent of average 1 day per month on AOCMF / AO affairs
- Desired - Team player who can work together to achieve goals
- Must - Willing and prepared to travel regionally (no exclusions)

Education related

- Must - Active AOCMF faculty, preferred holding a position at an university or academic institution
- Desired - Recognized as excellent educator

¹ Any Re-election shall follow the same procedure and rules as a regular election. If the person is nominated for re-election (currently or in the past holds the chair) a 2/3rd majority vote by the overall electorate is required. The longest extension possible for a re-elected chair is 3 years.

- Must - Highly motivated to contribute to build and maintain educational programs
- Must - Holds/held an AOCMF faculty or chairman position

- Desired – Relevant Research experience
- Desired - Good scientific reputation regionally, supported by high quality academic publications, book etc.
