## Guidance for the preparation of curriculum vitae

The CV should be typed and printed in English.

The mission is to foster and expand our network of healthcare professionals in education, research, development, and clinical investigation to achieve more effective patient care worldwide.

The CV should reflect the applicant's or nominee's contributions to this endeavor and address the requirements defined in the Job description of the AOCMF Specialty Board Chair.

Details should be given under the general headings, which form the basis of the summary sheet attached.

Additional information may include significant oral presentations, research applications granted (dates, project titles, amounts granted, granting bodies, etc.) and a short statement must be given of those of the nominee's attributes most likely to contribute to the activities of the Foundation.

The CV should be signed and dated by the applicant.

The Summary sheet must have a recent passport-size portrait photograph of the nominee. This sheet should be completed in English, either typewritten or printed.

**Persons eligible for Nomination** are expected to be, or to have been for some time, engaged actively in the field of research, teaching and/or clinical practice in fracture surgery and to be distinguished in their chosen field. Their activities should be such that they further the aims of the Foundation.
